As you move forward to further your education, the Medgar and Angela Scott Foundation would like to assist you. This scholarship aims to provide students with an opportunity to further their education in a world of growing costs and challenges. Our organization is dedicated to helping young men and women advance their education.

We are announcing our 2025 Scholarship Program. We will award four (4) scholarships totaling \$15,000 to outstanding students in the Vicksburg area.

- 1. Medgar Scott Memorial Scholarship
- 2. Angela Scott STEM Scholarship
- \$5,000 award to a male student
- \$5,000 award to a female STEM student
- 3. Medgar and Angela Scott Scholarship \$2,500 award each to two students

The criteria for eligibility of our scholarship program:

- A graduating senior planning to pursue a bachelor degree and has been <u>accepted</u> to a four-year college/university
- Copy of Acceptance letter from College/University
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or above on a 4.0 scale shown on a transcript from the applicant's school. (A scanned copy is sufficient)
- Copy of ACT and/or SAT scores
- Demonstrated involvement in applicant's school activities and community
- Two letters of recommendations:
 - One (1) from one of the applicant's teachers or school counselor
 - One (1) from someone that has known the applicant while he or she attended high school but is <u>not</u> a relative, i.e., a neighbor, church member, friend of your parents
- Submission of a 500-word essay (see page 4 for instructions)
- Attach a color photograph (jpeg print quality headshot)

Compose an essay of 500 words on one of the topics below. Essays must be typed, double spaced, in 12-point font with one-inch margins on all sides.


Topics
